

## **Bring Your Own Device 2025 Participation Agreement**

At Heatley Secondary College, we encourage students to use digital technology to enhance their learning and get ready for the world of work after completing their education. A decision has been made to allow all students to Bring their Own Device to connect to the school network to use in classes (when appropriate) and to take home to complete their homework and any assessment.

## **PARTICIPATION**

Students who participate in the BYOx program at Heatley Secondary College will be required to:

- Bring their device every day (fully charged)
- Follow teacher instructions
- Establish a constructive learning relationship
- Be resourceful and independent in optimising the potential of technology
- Recognise when and where to use their laptop (both for school use and leisure)

## **MODELS**

The school will allow students to bring any device as long as it meets the requirements below.

Supported Systems		
Operating System	Version	Hardware
Apple macOS <sup>1</sup>	12 and later	MacBook, MacBook Air or MacBook Pro
Apple iOS/iPadOS <sup>2</sup>	13.0 and later	iPad or iPad Pro
Microsoft Windows <sup>3</sup>	11	Laptop or Tablet

- 1 Apple Laptops newer then 2020 should be compatible with the school network.
- 2 Apple iPads should be a minimum size of a 32GB and have a strong case that protects the iPad from damage and a keyboard.
- 3 Windows based devices are required to have a minimum of 4GB RAM. It is also recommended these devices have a processor of at least Intel i3 (or equivalent). All devices require at least 80GB of free Hard Drive space. If subjects are being completed such as Graphics, Art, Design; higher specifications are recommended such as 8GB RAM and a processor of at least Intel i5 (or equivalent).

Windows 10 should work on the network. Windows 10 in S mode will need to be switched out. Instructions to do this can be found on the Microsoft Windows 10 in S mode FAQ.

Android, Chromebook/Chrome OS, and Linux devices are not supported on the DoE network.

The school's wireless network only supports 5GHz devices.



Microsoft Office is available free for current school students. Information on how to download Microsoft Office can be found at - https://education.qld.gov.au/parents-and-carers/school-information/internet-at-school

BYOx is free for students to bring their own laptop to school and connect to the school network. Technical help will be available on with connecting the laptop to the school network. Any faults with the computer will not be corrected at school.
