This funding will be used to


- Attain 100% QCE/QCIA for Year 12 students

- Decrease School Disciplinary Absences by 20%

Our initiatives include


- Continue to improve attendance, effort and behaviour in all year levels

- Employ an additional 4.29 FTE \$364 650

- Employ 1 additional Teacher Aide to provide in class literacy and numeracy support \$41 538
